Dear Friends of the VSMF,

Our 2023 festival concluded with two excellent concerts, featuring the UK-based **Marmen Quartet**. Victoria's own **Yariv Aloni, viola** joined the quartet in the second concert.

The first performance in our final week included Mozart's Quartet in E flat Major, K428 and Beethoven's Quartet op. 59 no. 2. A well-deserved standing ovation was rewarded with an encore of a lovely rendition of "Somewhere Over the Rainbow".

In the second concert, the quartet performed Haydn's Quartet op. 50 no. 2, and, with Yariv Aloni, the Ralph Vaughan Williams Phantasy Quintet. The quartet then played Salina Fisher's "Heal", a commissioned piece, and the evening concluded with Bartok's Quartet No. 4. Following another standing ovation, the enthusiastic crowd was treated to the third movement of Mozart's K159: Rondo - allegro grazioso.
